Data Analyst

Project Background:

The Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO) for the benefit of the Palestinian Authority has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Water Security Development - Gaza Central Desalination Program: Associated Works Project Phase I (AWP-Phase 1), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services to support capacity building and performance improvement of selected institutions.

The overall objective of the capacity building component will be primarily to create adequate capacity to ensure operations and maintenance of the STLVs during project implementation and subsequently during the O&M of the integrated bulk water supply system supported by the project. This component will also support the design of a National Service Provider Improvement Program (NSPIP) to improve service delivery in the West Bank and Gaza, and reduce the need for sector subsidies, as well as to prepare priority bulk water investments in the West Bank.

The PWA is considering the recruitment of a qualified data analyst who will contribute to the successful implementation of the project.

Project Components

- Component 1: Improved Supply of Bulk Water to the southern and middle governorates of Gaza
- 2. Component 2: Capacity Building and Performance Improvement of Selected Institutions
 - Sub-component 2.1: Establishment of a unit to operate bulk water supply in Gaza Sub-component 2.2: Design of a National Service Provider Improvement Program Sub-component 2.3: Priority investment planning for bulk water supply in the West Bank
- 3. Component 3: Project Management and Implementation Support

Assignment Objective:

The objective of the position is to support the analysis, coordination, implementation and development of activities related to transboundary management within PWA in both water and wastewater, with a focus on Wadi Asmen catchment area. The World Bank is currently working with PWA to develop Wadi Asmen transboundary study that is designed to reduce net lending. The position will closely follow up with the World Bank study but later on support PWA in replicating the experience in other hotspots.

The data analyst will report to the Water Expert /Water Information system Manager. Under the guidance of the Water Information system Manager, the data analyst will be following various Technical Assistance activities.

Essential Duties:

- 1. Data management: compilation of data related to costs of wastewater treatment in Israel, net lending, quality of water discharged into Israel, and related key data.
- 2. Analysis: conducting research related to transboundary matters, and providing analysis and recommendations related to transboundary issues.
- 3. Donor coordination: follow up and attend meetings related to different donor funded initiatives on transboundary aspects.
- 4. Networking: work with stakeholders including NGOs to advance regional dialogue and promote mutual cooperation.
- 5. Strategy development: work inside PWA to support the drawing up of a regional water management plan based on the above tasks.
- 6. Perform other duties as may be assigned by the IDM and Water Expert / Water Information System Management

Key Qualifications:

- Proven managerial record preferably with a B. A in a field of engineering, GIS, IT or equivalent.
- At least three (3) years of prior similar experience in water sector in the field Data collection and management or similar sector
- Proficiency in using GIS for mapping and analysis is highly required.
- Proficiency in using Advanced Microsoft Excel or Data Base for data analysis.
- Proficiency in English language (Reading, Writing and Reporting)
- Have high Analytical skills
- Strong communication skills, leadership to make change.
